OCTOBER MEETING MINUTES

The October 29, 2011 meeting was held at Killeen Field. President, Mike Stone, opened the meeting at 10:13am with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Minutes of the September 2011 Meeting were approved as written. Mike Stone noted that our member, Oscar Weingart, recently had quadruple heart bypass surgery. Bill Rothenbuhler then gave the Treasurer's Report, stating the balances in our Checking and Savings Accounts.

Bob Estrella gave the Membership Report, stating we have 81 members. Bob mentioned that he has distributed an updated Membership Roster by email and snailmail. Safety Officer, Roy Truitt, reminded members that, in the case of a crash, the crashed airplane should be left alone at the crash site until all other pilots have landed their models. Mike Wheel added a reminder to be careful about loose clothing, especially now that winter is upon us and jackets will often be worn. Loose clothing can get caught up in a prop and result in serious consequences.

Roy Truitt also reminded members to be sure to use the "Pin Box" if

you are using a 72MHz Radio. Also, that we still would like all pilots to sign in when they are at the Field.

Old Business:

Mike Stone discussed the status of our Incorporation/Non-Profit Initiative. Paperwork for Incorporation is complete, and just needs to be filed.

Mike Wheel reviewed the status of the Field Improvement Projects. He stated that the 3 new Start-up stands are complete, and that two of them were built at no cost to the Club. Mike also related that the Pin Box has been moved to the rear of the Pit area and the new windsocks are installed. He asked for volunteers to help him on November 5th to patch cracks in the Runway.

Bob Estrella stated that the Club has purchased new Website Design Software (Microsoft Expression Studio 4 Web Professional), and Training Material. Bob said that he will re-do the Club Website and

document the design so that others will be able to easily take over Site Maintenance in the future if that becomes necessary.

Detailed plans for the November 12th Members Appreciation Fun-Fly were discussed. It was decided that the Fun-Fly events would be: Poker Run; Spot Landing; Timed Takeoff, Loop, Roll, and Land; and Egg Drop. It was further decided that Electrics would only be allowed in the Poker Run Event and during Open Flying. Electrics will not be allowed in any of the other Fun-Fly Events. It was also decided that "dropping mechanisms" would be allowed in the Egg Drop Event.

New Business:

There was much discussion about the restriction placed on us during the Duck Hunting Season, i.e. that there can be no flying at all at our Field on Wednesdays and Saturdays. Mike Stone related that it is likely that the restriction will be relaxed later on in the Hunting Season (i.e. flying allowed after 9am). In view of that, it was agreed that we will not "fight" the current restriction right now, and that Mike Stone will continue to diplomatically negotiate with the leadership of the Duck Hunter Group.

New Business: (continued)

Mike Stone noted that the Corona Club was holding their Lake Perris Float-Fly this weekend. Bob Estrella presented the proposed Gilman Springs RC Flyers 2012 Event Schedule, and it was approved by an affirmative vote by meeting attendees. The 2012 Schedule is shown here, and it includes the planned 2012 events of the Hemet Model Masters and the Menifee Valley Flyers. It also shows the tentative rescheduling of our "Members Appreciation Fun-Fly" to Saturday March 24, 2012.

Mike Stone asked for a volunteer to handle Restroom Cleanup & Trash Disposal for November/December 2011. New member Joe Holmes volunteered. **THANK YOU JOE!** Mike Wheel then reminded members to please put empty soda cans and water bottles (caps removed) in the designated containers, **not** in the trash containers.

Show and Tell: (see photos herein) Dennis Milliken showed his Nitro Models Electric B25. It has retracts, a 57" wingspan, and the kit costs \$275.

Bob Estrella showed his FunCub on Floats, stating that he flew it at the Menifee Valley Flyers Heritage Lake Float-Fly on October 2nd. It is an electric, elapor foam, ARF and it has a wingspan of 55".
